

When to use your Registered Agent's (RA) Address?

VS

When to use your business address, P.O Box, or Virtual Office Address?

- Texas Comptroller's Office (ex. Franchise Tax or Sales Tax Notices)
- Texas Secretary of State (In business filings, use the RA address in the designated RA sections of LLC, PLLC, Non-Profit applications).
- Legal notices from private & public agencies.
- Internal Revenue Service (IRS) (The RA cannot be used for the company's business address. However, it can be used as the mailing address, if needed).

- Banks and Financial Institutions (bank and credit card statements)
- Dun & Bradst Application process.
- Internal Revenue Service (IRS)
- Monthly bill statements for your company-related expenses. (ex. commercial Insurance, internet, and phone bills).
- Non-official mail, packages, inventory, products.
